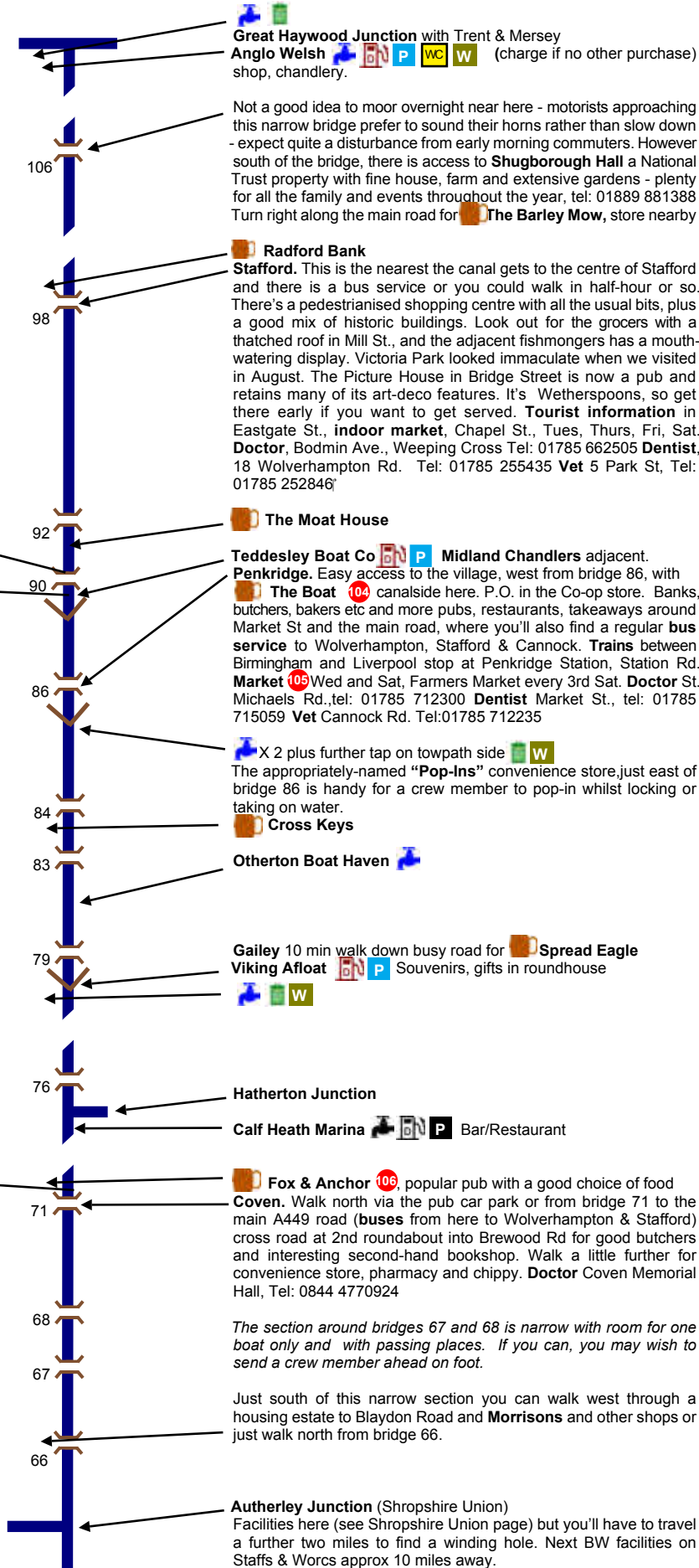

The Boat Dating back to 1711, the Boat is popular with locals and boaters. There's a traditional bar and a comfortable lounge where you can enjoy home-cooked food and cask-conditioned beers and guest ales. Children welcome, traditional Sunday lunch. Plenty of moorings nearby. Open all day 11am to Midnight, Noon to 11 Sunday.

Penkrige Market. Open every Wednesday and Saturday with over 100 stalls. Farmers Market every third Saturday of the month with lots of fresh produce. Market and Car Boot Sale on Bank Holiday Mondays.

Fox & Anchor a deceptively large pub which is split up into more discreet areas to provide a relaxing experience. Good speedy service, well-kept beer and value-for-money food make this a popular destination for visitors from Wolverhampton as well as locals and boaters. Children welcome, large canalside patio area, open daily 11 -11, Noon - 10.30 Sunday
